Join us for worship on Sunday, June 2 at 11 am as we commission our adults and youth going on summer mission trips abroad. Please continue to keep them in your prayers as they head into the mission field this month to carry out Christ's ministry.

Eleven members are serving in Rwanda. They will visit several churches and ministries in Kigali that are working for peace and development. They'll also spend time with three students from Rwanda who are attending Samford University through the Bridge2Rwanda program.

Another three adults and eight youth will be in the Chiapas region of Mexico doing light construction work. They will be plastering walls and painting several Sunday Schools in the towns of Aguas manantiales, Ruiz Cortines, 20 de Noviembre and Pancho villa.
